	EFFECTIVE DATE: 12/1/10

PURPOSE: To ensure that parents/guardian are aware and consent to children's activities outside of normal play.

POLICY:

1. The agency expects all foster parents to use all safety precautions necessary for foster children during their participation in any play or sporting activities.
2. The agency recommends that foster children use safety equipment such as helmets and kneepads for bicycles and roller blades when in use as a precautionary measure.
3. The following activities for children in custody require the written permission of the parent/guardian on the attached permission sheet:

- Water slides
- Boating
- Horse back riding
- Exercise Equipment
- Lawn mowing
- Weed trimming
- Sports
- Dirt bike riding
- Camping
- Trampoline
- Three or Four Wheelers
- Skiing
- Any other use of a motorized vehicle (i.e. mopeds, tractors, etc.)
