Some Warning Signs

Does Your Partner:

- Show anger or impatience when your child cries or has a tantrum?
- Call your child BAD NAMES or put him/her down?
- Stop you from bringing your child to his family events?
- Think its funny to SCARE your child?
- Make ALL the decisions for you and your child?
- Tell you that you are a bad parent or that you should not have your kids?
- Pretend that WHEN HE HURTS YOUR CHILD that you are to BLAME or its NO BIG DEAL?
- Make your child SCARED by using guns or knives or other weapons?
- Tell you that your child is a nuisance?
